



Solid color info sheet:

Solid color tile was originally designed to be used as an accent or to be cut into feature strips. However, many in the A+D community prefer to use solid color tile as an overall field. This use has come into greater prominence in recent years. Therefore we would like to point out some concerns.

Due to the absence of texture or visual contrast in the floor, solid color tile will tend to show more scratches, scuffs, and dirt than a textured or patterned floor. Solid color tile will also require more frequent maintenance due to the absence of contrast. The wear ability of the floor is exactly the same as any other product of the same construction. We have had success with the use of solid color flooring on such projects as US treasury department, DSS TV Headquarters and Jordan Marsh dept store. However, it is for you the designer, and the client to decide if you want the solid color visual and to decide if you can accept the potential greater maintenance issues.

Allstate warrants the wear of the solid color tile but not the visual aspects of the floor when installed as an overall field.
